Reached 10,414 people with Health, Hygiene, and Sanitation (HHS) messages through different trainings and ministry forums





“As woman, I know how difficult life can get without water because it is our responsibility to look for water for our families.”

“Before the drilling of the new borehole, it was very difficult for us as women to organize and implement our planned church activities because most female members would either spend most of their time looking for water, or not be willing to attend church events because they would spend the whole day without drinking water or eating.”

“Today, I am very excited to testify that we are now able to confidently plan any church events or gatherings because we are confident that we will have water to cook with or to drink. The women also have more time to attend any organized events at the church because they no longer have to go to far places in search of water. May God bless you for the good work you have done in Matu, and particularly for the people of God.”

“My understanding and training in DMM (Disciple Making Movement) and DBGs (Discovery Bible Groups) really changed my life and view of evangelism. Many members of my family used to abuse alcohol and my parents would fight almost every day. Every time we saw our father, we would run and hide because we knew there would be trouble.”

“When I started my DBG, both my father and mother began attending and soon after gave their lives to Jesus Christ. Since accepting Jesus Christ, peace is returning to our family. "As the cluster leader of this village, it always broke my heart to see my people, and even my family fetch water from a dirty stream that we shared with cattle and goats "shares Santo about the water difficulties in his village.

"Because the water was always so dirty, we had common cases of bilharzia, hook worms and typhoid fever among many members of the community, yet it is very difficult for them to afford good medical care."

"I am so grateful today to God and 4africa for the gift of a new borehole that will provide clean water to the people of Koloro. On behalf on the community and on my own behalf, I want to say thank you from the bottom of my heart 4africa and the donors who funded the well."

IMPACT STORIES

Poni was interviewed with five others at her high school to be given a chance to enter the Leadership Academy of South Sudan (LASS). Of that group, only she was accepted, and she wonders why the Lord gave her such an opportunity! It is only His grace and provision and she is forever grateful.

In 2014 when entering LASS, she was not comfortable around other people especially other tribes and men. She learned a lot through the LASS programs and they built her into who she is now. The topics and the real-life applications encouraged her to grow in ways that she would have never imagined. Poni was elected as a care group leader, which required her to lead a group of other female students at LASS. Through that experience she learned to be free to talk, share, lead, and love others and she thanks God that she can handle people very well. She also learned how to pray and the importance of it. Growing up, she always went to church because her dad was a pastor, but she never knew God in the way she does now.

These lessons have allowed Poni to grow in university because she found herself surrounded with people from various backgrounds and beliefs. Poni is keeping with the mindset of strong study and academic skills- and she has steadily increased her GPA each semester! Her experiences in our Leadership Program and faith in Christ give Poni the platform to be an example of a Christian women to her fellow classmates.

Poni is soon to graduate with a business administration degree and is very focused on wanting to develop a creative project that is well run to support herself and others. Because she has been helped so much personally and with school fees, she wants to extend help the way that she has been helped. She learned that to whom much is given, much is expected.
